- Two peaks, one resort! Attitash and Bear Peak both offer base lodges with all amenities and parking. Each peak has a unique feeling, with Attitash trails being a bit more narrow and winding, while Bear

Peak trails tend to be more wide open and are a favorite for local race teams. Bear Peak is also host to Abenaki Parks.

- Our sister mountain, Wildcat Mountain is just 20 minutes away and is on the same lift ticket and season pass.
- The Attitash After Dark concert series in Ptarmigan's Pub appeals to the 21+ crowd looking to party after a day on the slopes.
- The U Go Girl race series offers a low-key racing series with 50% of proceeds going to a local cancer fund, Jen's Friends. Races are held on January 11, 2020, January 19, 2020, February 16, 2020, and March 8, 2020.
- A local favorite, the Grandstand Mogul Jam is not to be missed! Grandstand is one of the best bump runs on the hill and once a year our events crew lets the trail it bump up au-natural and builds two jumps in the middle for thrills and spill that keep spectators coming back all-day-long. The party then continues in Ptarmigan's, led by 80's cover band, Ovation.
- Great dining experiences abound in North Conway area, named #1 Ski Town In The US by USA Today. Local favorites include farm-to-table dining at The Thompson House in Jackson, NH, amazing craft beer offerings from Tuckerman Brewing Company, and the apres scene at the world-famous Red Parka Pub in Glen, NH.
